

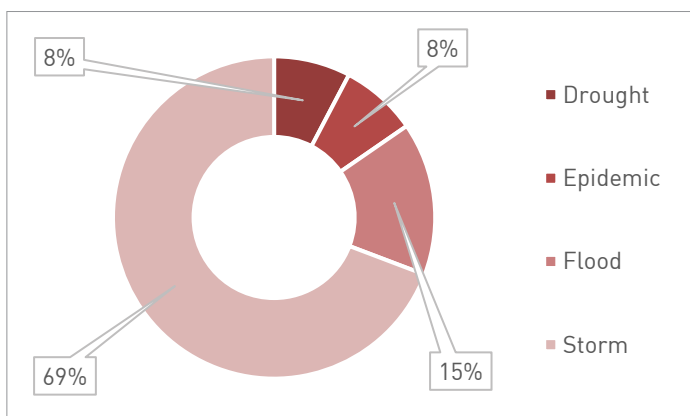

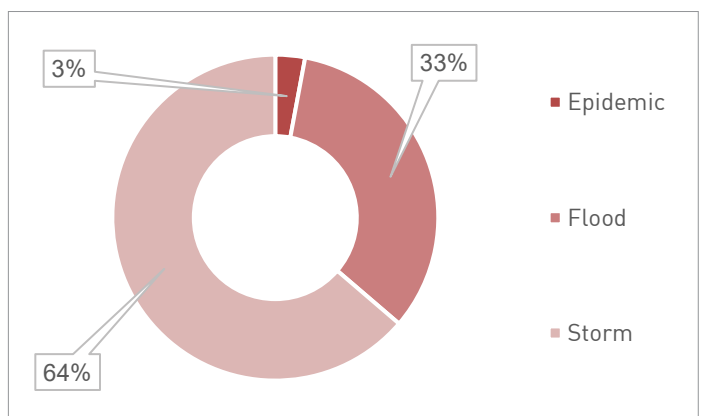
A. WORLD RISK INDEX
